

PSRI Favorite Places to Photograph ----- Instructions

Place: A title for the place or subject(s). Provide website if available.

Submitted by: Your name

Location: Address

Cost/Fees: Note the admission fees, cost of parking, and any other costs associated with being there. If there are not costs, enter Free.

Parking and Availability: Where to park safely, Note if conditions at site include rough walkways, wet conditions, voracious insects, etc., that would require special precautions.

What You'll be Shooting: What are the subjects available at this location.

Best Season and/or Time of Day: The best times to be at this site to take advantage of light, conditions, foliage, etc. Opening and closing times, if important.

Recommended Equipment: What items in addition to the camera are helpful? Tripod? Flash? Reflector? Types of lenses: macro, wide angle, telephoto, big telephoto, etc.

Accessibility: Is the site next to the road or parking lot? How far a walk is it to the item of photographic interest? Is it indoors or outdoors only? Is it difficult walking, smooth paths, paved paths, or bushwacking?

Other Points of Interest in the Area: What else is nearby that may be of photographic interest?

Directions: Give driving directions to the site. Try to be specific. Use a well-known location as a starting point, such as, Drive south on I-95 from Providence . . .”
