He has won many awards in photographic competitions including first place in the Wild Lands category of the Defenders of Wildlife photography contest, and the Audubon Society of Greater Denver. In 2010 Joe was recognized as a Highly Honored Photographer in the prestigious Nature's Best Windland Smith Rice International Awards Competition. Joe is a staff instructor at the Adirondack Photography Institute <http://www.adkpi.org/>, which offers photographic workshops and tours throughout the spectacular Adirondack region of upstate New York, and in other select locations in the northeast.
