David Middleton is a nationally recognized professional nature photographer, writer and naturalist. His philosophy is to photograph whatever he finds attractive which leads him to photograph subjects and places as disparate as harbors, wildflower meadows, large mammals, small birds, forests, quaint villages, indigenous markets, people and mountain streams.

David has written and photographed for more than 20 years and traveled extensively throughout all of North and South America, Antarctica and Africa. His photography and writing is regularly featured in many magazines, books and calendars. David has led tours and workshops for many organizations including Maine Photographic Workshops, Rocky Mountain School of Photography, The Great American Photography Weekend, Santa Fe Workshops, Coupeville Arts Center, Nature's Best Photography School, the National Audubon Society, the National Wildlife Federation, Penn. State University, Voyagers International and the Orvis Company. David is also a Contributing Editor for Outdoor Photographer Magazine and on the Board of Rockport College, a fine arts school in Rockport Maine.

David has produced several books including: *Ancient Forests*, *The New Key to Ecuador and the Galapagos*, *Prayers through the Seasons*, *American Vision*, and the largest nature photography book project ever undertaken, *The Nature of America*, which he created, co-directed, contributed photographs to and wrote. His new books are *The Nature of Vermont* and *The Photographer's Guide to Vermont*, *The Photographer's Guide to the Maine Coast* and *The Photographer's Guide to the Oregon Coast* all published by The Countryman Press.

More than an outdoor photographer and naturalist, David is a **gifted and enthusiastic teacher** who truly enjoys sharing his experiences and expertise with people. David teaches about 15 workshops a year on photography, writing and creativity. He sees approximately 1000 students a year and critiques about 10,000 images a year. Overall, David has led more than 150 tours and taught more than 200 workshops. He presently lives on an old dairy farm in the Green Mountains of Vermont. David has related to me that he does not shoot during workshops but holds himself out to all for guidance and questions which he strongly encourages.

DIRECTIONS TO NORWOOD BAPTIST CHURCH

48 Budlong Ave. in Warwick, RI.

From 95:

North or South, take exit 14, Rt. 37 E. to Rt 1 Post Rd. Stay to the left on Rt. 37 and this will put you on Post Rd. North. Go by Gregg's restaurant on your left. Go through the next traffic light (Elm St.) Two more intersections on your left and take a left on Norwood Ave. (Floral Memories florist on the corner, Plaza with Papa John's Pizza on right).

Pass by the Norwood Elementary School on your right. You will go over two speed bumps in front of the school. At the second speed bump take a left. (Frederick St.)

Go two intersections and take a right at the first stop sign (Philips Ave). This will bring you to the back of the church on your left. This is where our parking lot is, or you can park on the street anywhere around the building.

From Elmwood Ave:

If your coming up Elmwood Ave. South, continue past Park Ave. Drive by AMF Cranston Bowl on the left. Continue past the light at Wellington Ave. Continue past Dunkin Donuts on the right. At the next traffic light (about three blocks) turn right on Pawtuxet Ave. In a few blocks you'll come to a stop sign (Suburban Pharmacy on left). Continue straight, drive by a gazebo on left. Just ahead, bear left around the small stone library. You are now on Budlong Ave. The church is just ahead on the left.
